

FIREFLOW FAQ

How do I request fire flow and pressure information from Santa Clarita Valley Water Agency?

To request fire flow and pressure information from Santa Clarita Valley Water Agency (SCVWA), first contact the Los Angeles County Fire Department (LACFD) Fire Prevention Division to determine what their requirements are for the property. What forms do I need?

You will need to obtain either the LACFD Form 195 which is for One and Two Family Dwellings, Townhomes, and Accessory Dwelling Units or LACFD Form 196, which is for all Buildings other than Single Family Dwellings.

What do I need to submit?

Complete, sign, and date Part I of the LACFD Form 195 or LACFD Form 196 and include a site plan identifying the requested area of the project.

Where do I submit my completed form?

Submit your completed form and site plan to SCVWA at fireflow@scvwa.org.

What happens once my Form 195 is submitted to SCVWA?

A receipt for your payment will be emailed to the email on the bottom of your application; Please allow a 10-day turn around for processing. Our business days do not include our Fridays off, holidays, and weekends. Once completed, the application and all back up documents will be sent to the email address on the bottom of the application. At this point, you are responsible to submit the completed form to the fire department to see what their requirements are.

Is there a fee?

There is no fee at this time. Unfortunately, we are unable to expedite turnaround time of these forms.

How long is the Fire Flow Valid?

The valid date information is stated on the form, but it is typically one year.
