PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

REBATES/INCENTIVES

\$3.00 per square foot for living grass removed
Optional Native Plant Bonus of an additional \$0.50 per square foot

PROJECT SIZE

Projects must be between 100 and 2,500 square feet of living grass to be removed
Customers can convert up to 5,000 sf per year, up to 20,000 sf total

LOCATION

Front yards, side yards, and backyards qualify

DESIGN REQUIREMENTS

PLANT COVERAGE

- Residential design must have at least 50% plant coverage at maturity (within 2 years)
- You may be able to use existing trees for plant coverage
- Remaining project area must be permeable material (e.g., mulch, decomposed granite, rock). Impermeable areas are not funded for residential projects.

PLANT TYPE

- A Native Plant Bonus is available for projects that use a majority native plants (25% of the total project area)
- Artificial turf is not funded for residential projects

IRRIGATION

New landscape should use drip or point irrigation, can be hand watered, or can use HE overhead spray nozzles if you have pressure regulation and a calibrated smart controller. Drip conversion, smart controller, and pressure regulation rebates are available.

Native Plant Bonus Incentive (Optional)	\$0.50 per SF
Design Assistance (Optional)	\$150 rebate

Pre and Post Inspections Required	Yes
SCV Water Authorization to Proceed Required Before Start	Yes
Eligible Areas	Front, Back, Side Yards; Hillsides
Partial Lawn Removal Allowed (can keep some grass)	Yes; must be separate zone(s)
Project area must be full zone(s)	Yes; 50% area or more must be living grass
Minimum Project Area	100 SF
Maximum Project Area Per Phase	2,500 SF
Maxium SF Per Account Per Year	5,000 SF
Maxium SF Per Account Total (All Phases)	20,000 SF
Plant Coverage at Maturity	50% of project area
Artificial Turf Funded	No
Irrigation Type*	Drip Irrigation or Qualified HE Nozzles (with Controller Callibration & Pressure Regulation (rebates available))
Maintenance Requirement	Must maintain landscape & not convert back to grass for a minimum of 10 years
Rebate Transfer Request to Contractor (Optional)	Yes

* Only high-efficiency nozzles from our Qualified Products List or with a precipitation rate of 1" per hour or less are eligible.

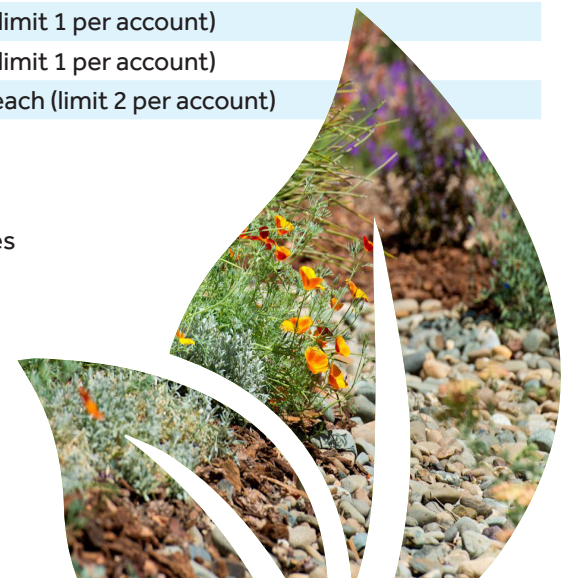

Sheet Mulching	\$0.50 per SF of Feature
Bee Hotel	Up to \$50 (limit 1 per account)
Owl Box	Up to \$50 (limit 1 per account)
Rain Barrel	Up to \$75 each (limit 2 per account)

Residential LRP Process Overview

Customers must complete all steps in each phase before moving to the next phase.



- 1 Start Online Application**
 - Create Online Profile
 - Start Application
 - Review & Confirm Requirements
 - Coordinate pre-inspection
- 2 Pre-Inspection**
 - Pre-Inspection
 - Accept notice of pre-approval
- 3 Design Assistance** OPTIONAL
 - Meet with landscape designer if participating in the Design Assistance Program
- Submit Project Details**
 - Upload Project Area Photos & Design Plan
 - Provide Project Details
 - Enter Plant List
 - Read & Submit Terms & Conditions
- 4 Authorization to Proceed**
 - Accept Notice to Proceed


DO NOT REMOVE GRASS JUST YET!
Grass removed prior to Step 5 will not qualify for the incentive.

- 6 Convert Your Landscape**
 - Remove Grass
 - Implement Your Conversion Plan
 - Take Photos
 - Save Documentation, Receipts, and Invoices
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- Remove Grass Upgrade Irrigation Install Plants Mulch & Finish

- 7 Complete Online Application**
 - Upload Photos of Your New Landscape & Receipts or Invoices
- 8 Verify Conversion**
 - Post-Inspection
- 9 Finalize Documentation**
 - Submit W-9, and/or
 - (Optional) Complete Rebate Transfer Request Form to forward rebate directly to contractor
- 10 Get Paid**
 - Check is mailed within 90-120 days
