2. The applicant shall notify Santa Clarita Water Division when he/she wishes to have service discontinued. The regular rates including monthly minimum charge shall continue until such notice has been received unless the service is discontinued under Section 1 above.
3. The applicant shall be responsible for all damages to company owned facilities and equipment furnished or used, and shall also hold Santa Clarita Water Division harmless from any liability from the use of the above-mentioned facilities.

ADDENDUM TO FIRE HYDRANT APPLICATION

1. An eddy valve must be used on the downstream side of the hydrant meter for flow control.
2. Hydrant meters are to be used only within Santa Clarita Water Division's service area and for the stated purpose as outlined on the signed application. Service is temporary and water is to be used for non-potable purposes.
3. The hydrant meter must be returned by the end of the duration period as outlined on the signed application. **If the hydrant is NOT returned to SCWD as outlined, the applicant forfeits all deposit money.**
4. The applicant is required to bring the hydrant meter to the utility between the 1st and 15th of every month for the monthly reading. **If the applicant fails to comply, then the applicant will be assessed a \$500 per day fee for everyday the hydrant meter is delinquent past the 15th of every month.**
5. Hydrant meters are not to be relocated from the authorized location.
6. Hydrants must be turned on and off with a hydrant wrench only.
7. It is also understood that Santa Clarita Water Division may reduce, interrupt or discontinue the service completely, should it become necessary in order to provide continued service to the permanent customers in the service area.
8. No private fire system will be used for any reason other than for fire protection without express written permission from property owner and Santa Clarita Water Division.
9. The applicant is solely responsible for keeping current all necessary fire permits. SCWD reserves the right to disconnect and confiscate the hydrant meter should the applicant fail to obtain and maintain a current fire permit per the Fire Department requirements.
