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

SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION

SCV Water's Devil's Den property encompasses 8,656 acres in Kern and Kings Counties. The Devil's Den Water District is an existing entity, although its State Water Project (SWP) contract rights of 12,700 Acre-Feet (AF) have been transferred to SCV Water. A summary of activities at the Devil's Den property during the first six months of 2024 are as follows:

 Groundwater levels are checked bi-annually at the north end of the property to monitor the potential effects of groundwater pumping by neighboring agriculture operations. Current water levels as of the July 2024 reading are approximately 70 feet below ground surface elevation. This reflects a decrease of 5 feet in the test wells' depth to water level over the last six months. Prior to 2010, typical static water levels were approximately 70 feet.



- 2. Currently there are 520 head of cattle being grazed on the Devil's Den site.
- 3. The agricultural lease between Rolling Hills Farms (RHF) and SCVWA will conclude on December 31, 2026.
- 4. Rolling Hills Farms continues mechanical weed control in areas of the property where cattle are not being grazed, such as fence lines and roadsides.
- 5. The property received approximately 5.0" of rain between January 2024 and July 2024.
- 6. Rolling Hills Farms requested 2,000 AF of State Water Project water for 2024 but was only granted 500 AF due to a low initial SWP allocation early in 2024. To date this year, 314 AF has been delivered to Devils Den for RHF use.
- 7. Rolling Hills Farms has planted 300 acres of non-irrigated barley and 75 acres of alfalfa in 2024. The alfalfa will need to be irrigated to survive. The 300 acres of 2024 barley plus an additional 400 acres of barley (planted in previous years that had not germinated due to lack of moisture) will be harvestable this year. The irrigated alfalfa should provide 6 cuttings this years.
- 8. SCV Water finalized an option lease agreement with IP Land Holdings, LLC (Intersect Power) on March 19, 2024, for approximately 8,133.67 acres of the Devils Den property for the purpose of solar generation.
- 9. SCV Water has received the initial option payment of \$488,020.00 for the first year of the option agreement. Option payments will continue on a yearly basis at an increased rate until Intersect Power decides to enter into the land lease agreement prior to construction or cancels the project altogether.
- 10. Intersect Power started their initial biological studies in June 2024 and has requested that SCV Water not disc the parcels currently not being farmed until further notice.
- 11. Interest Power is also currently working on securing their generation interconnection to connect the proposed project to the transmission line.
