Summary of Outreach and Engagement to Interested Parties

Throughout the planning period, SCV Water maintained and regularly updated a comprehensive contact list categorizing interested parties. The table below documents the comprehensive outreach and engagement effort undertaken by SCV Water during the UWMP process from July 2025 through April 2026. Outreach targeted a broad range of stakeholders, including government agencies, elected officials, environmental organizations, business groups, tribal representatives, and members of the public.

SCV Water used multiple engagement methods, with email outreach as the primary tool. Most agencies and organizations received between 5 and 7 emails, with some key stakeholders receiving additional communications. The public was reached through a Constant Contact email list of approximately 15,600 subscribers, who received emails announcing UWMP workshops, draft availability, and public hearing notices.

Early engagement was emphasized through letters at the start of the planning effort and invitations to workshops, which were sent to nearly all stakeholder groups. Many stakeholders were also offered requests to meet, and several participated in individual meetings, particularly business groups, environmental organizations, local governments, and tribal representatives.

Formal public process milestones were supported by outreach, including a 60 day public hearing notice. The UWMP draft Engagement results show that while not all groups submitted comments or attended workshops, several environmental organizations, public groups, and agency representatives participated in workshops and provided feedback.

The table illustrates that SCV Water implemented broad, consistent, and layered outreach throughout the UWMP process, using early notification, repeated email communications, meeting opportunities, and required public notices to encourage awareness, participation, and feedback from a wide and diverse set of stakeholders.

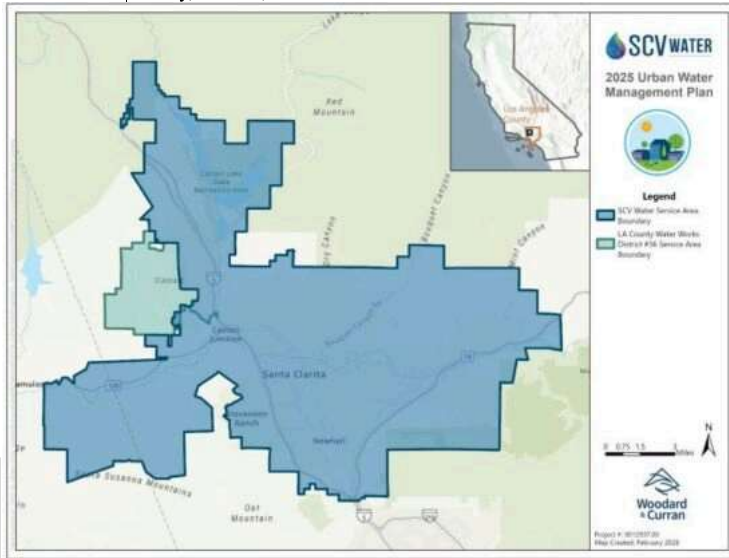

The Urban Water Management Plan is a state-required planning document, updated every five years, that guides how the agency will provide reliable water service for the Santa Clarita Valley community over the next two decades.

The Urban Water Management Plan describes how water is used in the Santa Clarita Valley, where water supplies come from, how SCV Water plans for drought and emergencies and how the Agency is preparing for future challenges such as climate change and population growth.

Members of the public are encouraged to review the Draft Urban Water Management Plan and provide public comment through April 28.

Public input is an important part of the process of developing the Draft Urban Water Management Plan, which must be submitted to the State of California by July 1.

All comments received during the public comment period will be documented, reviewed by staff and the project team and considered before the plan is finalized and presented for adoption.

Additionally, SCV Water will hold a public workshop via Zoom on Wednesday, April 1, at 6 p.m. to review the Draft Urban Water Management Plan with attendees.

This is a prime opportunity for those interested in the plan to understand each of its components and ask questions of SCV Water staff and the project team.

The public comment period leads to the first of two public hearings. On Tuesday, April 28, at 6 p.m., the SCV Water Board of Directors will meet to review the Draft Urban Water Management Plan and take public comment.

The public can attend this hearing at the SCV Water Administration Building at 27234 Bouquet Canyon Road, Santa Clarita, CA 91350, or via Zoom.

The SCV Water Board of Directors is scheduled to hold a second public hearing on Tuesday, June 9, at 6 p.m. to consider the final 2025 Urban Water Management Plan for adoption.

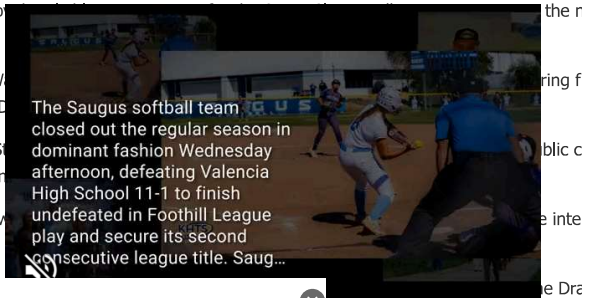


