## Commercial Drip Irrigation Rebate Application

### CUSTOMER AGREEMENT AND REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Applications will be funded on a first come, first served basis, provided the customer meets all qualifying criteria. There is no implied or expressed guarantee that funds will be available at the time the application is received by SCWD. Program terms and conditions are subject to change without prior notification.
- 2) SCWD has the right to reject any and all applications that are deemed by SCWD at its discretion to not be complete.
- 3) Entire irrigation zone(s)/station(s) should be replaced with drip irrigation.
- 4) Project must be completed within 120 days of approved start date.
- 5) Drip irrigation components must have flow rates measured in gallons per hour (gph) not gallons per minute (gpm).
- 6) Customer must use pressure regulator(s), backflow prevention device(s), and filter(s) devices.
- 7) Rebate application must include an original receipt within 120 days of project approval date for the purchase of qualifying equipment.
- 8) Original paid receipts and/or paid invoices must include transaction date(s) name and telephone number of the service provider, and payment method. This must be submitted to receive a rebate. Actual final rebate amount will be determined by SCWD.
- 9) SCWD does not endorse specific consultants, brands, products or dealers; nor does it guarantee materials or workmanship; acceptance of such is the sole responsibility of the customer.
- 10) SCWD has no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to a customer's property or other property or person as a result of participation in this program and customer waives all rights to bring any action against SCWD in connection with the Commercial Drip Irrigation Program.
- 11) SCWD does not guarantee that irrigation retrofits and changes will result in lower utility costs and customer waives all rights to bring any action against SCWD in connection with such.
- 12) A representative of SCWD must be permitted to conduct a pre- and post-inspection and any other inspections deemed necessary.
- 13) Maintenance of the drip irrigation system is the sole responsibility of the customer.
- 14) Installation of drip irrigation must be conducted at a location within SCWD's service area to be eligible for the program.
- 15) The Commercial Drip Irrigation Program only applies to areas that have existing spray head irrigation.
- 16) Minimum conversion is 500 square feet. Maximum conversion is 6000 square feet.
- 17) If the customer chooses to hire a landscape contractor or other professional to do installation of drip irrigation, this is the sole responsibility of the customer.
- 18) Site changes made related to rebate program must comply with all applicable laws, codes, policies, conditions and restrictions.
- 19) Customer must provide a site scale map that includes a landscape and irrigation plan.
- 20) Customer understands that this rebate is only in the form of a credit on their water bill.

**CONVERSION AREA**

Commercial Drip Irrigation Rebate: \$0.25 per SF (up to 6,000 SF) of area converted from overhead spray to drip irrigation. Maximum rebate is \$1,500 per site.
