- The Facility Capacity Fees and Charges are calculated based on methods endorsed by the American Water Works Association (AWWA) and presented in the Water Rate AWWA Manual M1.
- Previously 5/8" x 3/4" and 3/4" meters were installed. The Agency no longer anticipates installation of meters smaller than 1" due to new requirements for the fire sprinkler systems in the new homes and the corresponding plan requirements.
- An applicant upsizing from a 5/8" meter to a 1" meter will receive a 40% credit on the 1" meter fee and an applicant upsizing from a 3/4" meter to a 1" meter will receive a 60% credit on the 1" meter fee.
