



Drip Irrigation Conversion Rebate Program

Newhall County Water District is offering to all commercial customers a rebate to replace standard sprinkler zones to a more efficient drip system zone.

What are the benefits of installing a drip system?

This is a water-saving alternative for shrub areas and anywhere sprinklers are used (including lawns). Drip systems allow for direct source watering, it only waters your plants. It eliminates overspray on sidewalks, fences, windows, and roads that can damage structures and create unsafe conditions for cars and pedestrians.

I'm not replacing my lawn do I still qualify for a rebate?

The Drip Irrigation Conversion Rebate is available to anyone who wishes to remove a standard Spray sprinkler system. A full zone must be replaced to qualify for a rebate.

Does it matter what type of drip system I install?

You can install any drip emitter with a flow rate of 2 gallons per hour or less. A system utilizing 100% spaghetti tubing (1/4 inch) tubing is not eligible for the rebate program.

How much is the rebate?

Rebate amounts are \$.25 per sq. ft. of covered area installed not to exceed the cost of the product. Maximum rebate is \$1,000 per water meter.

What do I need to do to receive a rebate?

Complete the Drip Irrigation Conversion Rebate Application, attach copies of the dated sales receipt(s), and mail or email to:
